



**NTBA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING  
Sunday, January 16, 2021  
Virtual via Zoom Meeting**

The President called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm.

**Todd Squire Complaint re: Youth Tournament Results**

- Letter from Todd Squire complaining about Youth Tournament results was read to Directors
- **Motion to not accept the complaint and leave results as posted- Bonnie Castrucci, seconded by Charlotte Konkle**
  - Trena discussed rule about averages and inquired about changing averages – no specifics about Sport Shot averages.
  - Charlotte contacted the different leagues to confirm averages after email complaints about averages
  - Paul inquired why these other complaints weren't considered by the board – Charlotte explained that Bonnie asked Todd Squire to put it in writing and send it in
  - Karl asked why the problems with averages not challenged by the end of the first game according to CTF rules any issues with averages be dealt with before the end of the first game.
  - Paul said that Todd regards the Thursday league NOT a sanctioned sport shot league contrary to league registration. Paul indicated that a specific sport shot must be laid down to be a true sport shot league, as a challenge shot league also has their specific conditions to be laid down
  - Charlotte said that a sport shot pattern must be put down even occasionally. If no sport shot put down, it is a house shot league.
  - Todd doesn't believe that it is a sport shot league and the bowlers don't believe it is a sport shot league because there was a house shot down for the first 6 weeks of the league
  - Paul suggested that we keep local rules to a minimum otherwise all CTF rules apply
  - Bonnie added about an amendment to the original complaint stating that no conversion of sport league averages were required – see CTF rule 201 (c) section 1b – if the bowler has a standard average and a sport average, no conversion of sport averages is required, bowler will enter with the highest average
  - **Vote: in favour – 0, opposed – 7, abstained 1 – Motion defeated**
- **Motion to accept the complaint – Bonnie Castrucci, Seconded – Liz Born**
  - Make adjustments to results as necessary
  - **Vote: in favour 7, opposed – 0, abstained 1 – Motion carried.**

Paul suggested that for future tournaments, the board review and discuss the basic rules prior to publishing. Each tournament sheet will be adjusted accordingly.

Charlotte confirmed that items on the original agenda, that was revised to this complaint only, will be discussed at the next meeting on February 27, 2022.
